# TTF 2024 Highlights Bihar's Important Impetus/Role in the Travel Industry

**Patna, November 06, 2024** – The 2024 edition of the Travel & Tourism Fair (TTF) successfully concluded in Patna after two days of dynamic exchanges, business networking, and enthusiastic participation from exhibitors and visitors alike. Hosted at the Samrat Ashok Convention Centre - Gyan Bhawan, the event attracted an impressive turnout, underscoring Bihar's growing significance as a tourism hub. This session was followed by a **Destination Presentation by Maharashtra Tourism**, highlighting the state's attractions, new travel packages, and cultural offerings. The performance showcased the rich cultural traditions of Bihar and drew significant attention from attendees.

**Day 2** continued with a high-impact session on '**Thrills and Trails: The Potential of Adventure Tourism**,' where industry veterans explored Bihar's untapped potential in adventure tourism. The engaging discussions provided a roadmap for future growth in this niche sector.

The event closed with a **Valedictory Ceremony and Awards Function**, which recognized the outstanding contributions of exhibitors and marked the culmination of TTF 2024 in Patna, Bihar. ### Launch of the 'Visit Terai' Initiative

TTF Patna 2024 hosted the launch of the 'Visit Terai' initiative, showcasing the Himalayan Terai (Foothills) as one of the richest areas in the world for biodiversity, wildlife, and culture along the India-Nepal border. This region spans over 1,000 km and is becoming increasingly accessible with improved roads and several visa-free entry points in West Bengal, Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, and Uttarakhand.

Tourists can explore notable attractions like the **Valmiki Tiger Reserve (VTR)** and the forests of **Chitwan** and **Parsa**, now easily reachable via the new **Thori (Bhikhna Thori)** checkpoint. The initiative aims to promote Terai as a premier destination, boosting tourism and supporting local economies.

TTF 2024 highlighted Bihar's tourism offerings, showcasing the state's rich heritage, spiritual significance, adventure tourism, and eco-tourism opportunities.
